

WHAT YOUR CAR IS TRYING TO TELL YOU



“PUT THE KETTLE ON, DEAR”

Engine Oil: Your engine oil might be running low or there's a problem with your oil pressure.



“HAVE YOU BEEN WORKING OUT?”

ABS: Anti-lock brakes malfunctioning. Your wheels could lock up during braking.



“HEY, HANDSOME *WINK*”

Battery: Faulty alternator or an electrical issue



“GOT ANY GUM?”

Airbag Malfunction: The light turns on if you've disabled the airbags or if it is malfunctioning.



“CHECKMATE?!”

Check Engine: Lights up when your car is due for service or when the engine's about to fail.



“HOLD TIGHT!”

Seatbelt Warning: If this light comes on, it means you haven't fastened your seatbelt.



“IS IT CANDY CANE SEASON ALREADY?”

Windscreen Washer: Lights up while washing your windshield.



“BABE, HAVE YOU WATERED THE PLANTS YET?”

Engine Temperature: There's not enough coolant, or your coolant is really hot.



“I'M A WITCH. HAVE YOU SEEN MY CAULDRON?”

Tire Pressure: The pressure in one or more tires is low. Improper tire pressure could result in a blowout.



“YOU'VE GOT MY ATTENTION”

Parking Brake: You're not going anywhere until you disengage the e-brake.
